Kitchen towels are provided, but bath and hand towels are not. Kitchens are fully equipped with microwave, coffee maker, toaster, stove and a full-size refrigerator/freezer. Blenders, mixers, and crock pots are available for check out at the main house, free of charge. Each cabin has a charcoal grill, but charcoal and lighter fluid is not provided.

Fishing boat and motors are available for rental, as is a pontoon boat. Canoe and kayak use are complimentary on a first come first serve basis. There is free internet in each cabin and a flat screen television in the rec room in the basement of the main house. Board games, puzzles, badminton, volley ball, bocce and croquet also are available for check out.

Check-in is any time after 3pm on Saturday with check-out by 10 AM on the following Saturday. These times may be adjusted when possible.
